

What is Watermark Del Mar?

Watermark Del Mar is a new residential community proposed at the intersection of Jimmy Durante Boulevard and San Dieguito Drive. This community will transform what is now a vacant lot into a welcoming northern gateway to Del Mar.

The project includes 48 new homes in a unique mix of oneand two-story buildings designed in a timeless, coastal-inspired architectural style. All of Watermark Del Mar's homes will be built to high-quality, "for sale" standards. While the majority of the homes will be market rate, the current project proposes to designate seven of the homes as affordable, with up to four of the affordable homes proposed to be deeded to the City.
